- Thursday:** St. Stanislaus Bishop; Martyr (*Bishop of Cracow who assisted the poor; slain by the oppressive and savage king, Boleslaus II the Bold; Patron of Poland.*)
- Saturday:** St. Martin I Pope; Martyr (*Deacon who served at the imperial court in Constantinople; combated emperor Constans II over Monothelite belief that Jesus had only a divine will and so was not truly human; after becoming the Pope, was forced from Rome to Constantinople where he was tried for treason; later he was exiled to Crimea where he died of starvation and ill-treatment; he was the last pope to be martyred.*)

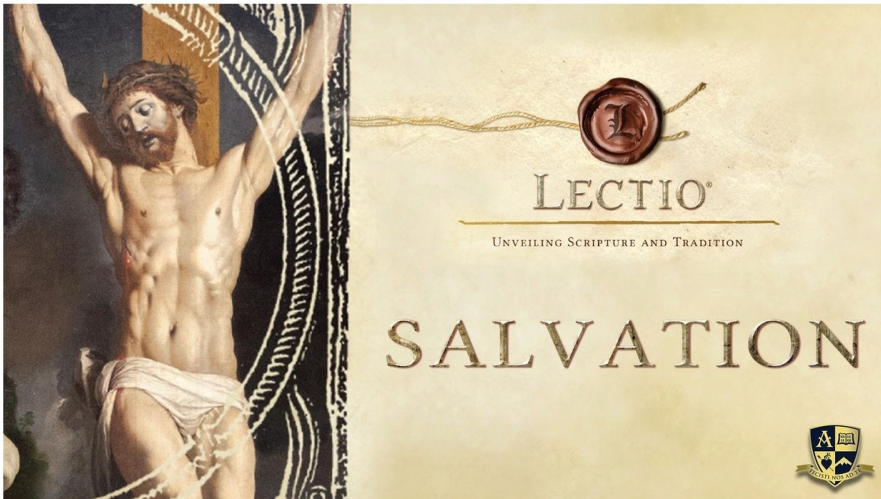

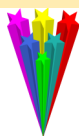
