### Special Observances

**Monday: St. Martin of Tours, Bishop** (From Pannonia in Hungary; soldier turned Christian at 18; disciple of St. Hilary; at Liguge, founded the first monastery in the West; bishop of Tours; first non-martyr with annual feast. In the Western Church; patron of soldiers, wine producers, and of France.)

**Tuesday: St. Josaphat, Bishop, Martyr** (Josaphat Kuncevych; born in Poland, raised Ukrainian Orthodox, becoming a Basilian monk of the Ruthenian Rite at Vilna; bishop of Polotsk; his fidelity to the Roman See and his desire for union between the Ukrainian Church and Rome led to his murder at Vitebsk; first formally canonized saint of the Eastern Rite.)

**Wednesday: St. Frances Xavier Cabrini, Virgin** (From Lombardy; youngest of 13 children; founded the Missionary Sisters of the Sacred Heart; for 28 years labored in US and South America, establishing some 67 institutions—schools, hospitals, and orphanages; first US citizen canonized; patroness of immigrants and migrants.)

**Friday: St. Albert the Great, Bishop, Doctor of the Church** (From Swabia; O.P. master of philosophy, theology, and the natural sciences, especially Aristotle; teacher of St. Thomas Aquinas; Provincial of the German Dominicans, becoming bishop of Regensburg; prolific writer—38 quarto volumes in print; wrote on the cult of the Sacred Heart; patron saint of scientists.)

**Saturday: St. Margaret of Scotland** (From Hungary; wife of King Malcolm III of Scotland and mother of eight; helped root out paganism; her love for the poor became legendary; patroness of Scotland.)

**St. Gertrude, Virgin** (Called "the Great"; born in Thuringia; mystic of the famous Benedictine abbey of Helfta in Saxony; wrote on the meaning of suffering, the Sacred Heart, the Trinity, and God's love; most important work: "Legatus Memorialis Abundantiae Divinae Pietatis.")
