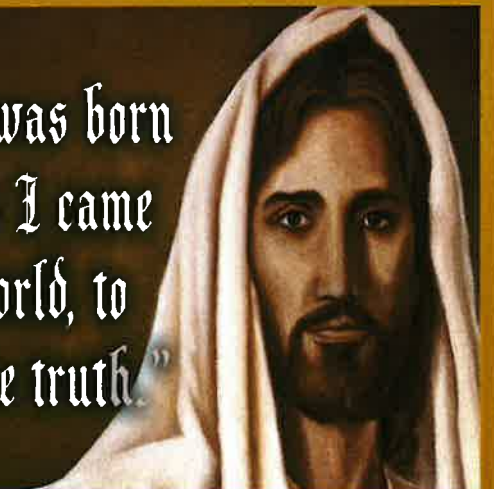

Special Observances

Monday: St. Catherine of Alexandria Virgin, Martyr (A learned woman of the early 4th century who, according to legend, following her conversion at age 18, preached the Gospel throughout Alexandria in Egypt. While imprisoned by the emperor Maxentius; she converted both the empress and the leader of the armed forces and for this she was martyred. Legend has that upon her death, after a wheel of torture (known as "Catherine's wheel") broke, her body was carried by angels to Mt. Sinai. St. Joan of Arc was thought to have heard her voice. Venerated in the East since the 9th century, she is a patron saint of philosophers, preachers, librarians, and young unmarried women.)



Saturday: St. Andrew Apostle (Brother of Simon Peter and disciple of John the Baptist; tradition holds he preached north of the Black Sea and in Greece, and died bound to an X-shaped cross, at Patras, Greece; patron of Russia and Scotland; as "Protoclete", (First Called), patron of the Greek Church; patron of fishing industry.)
