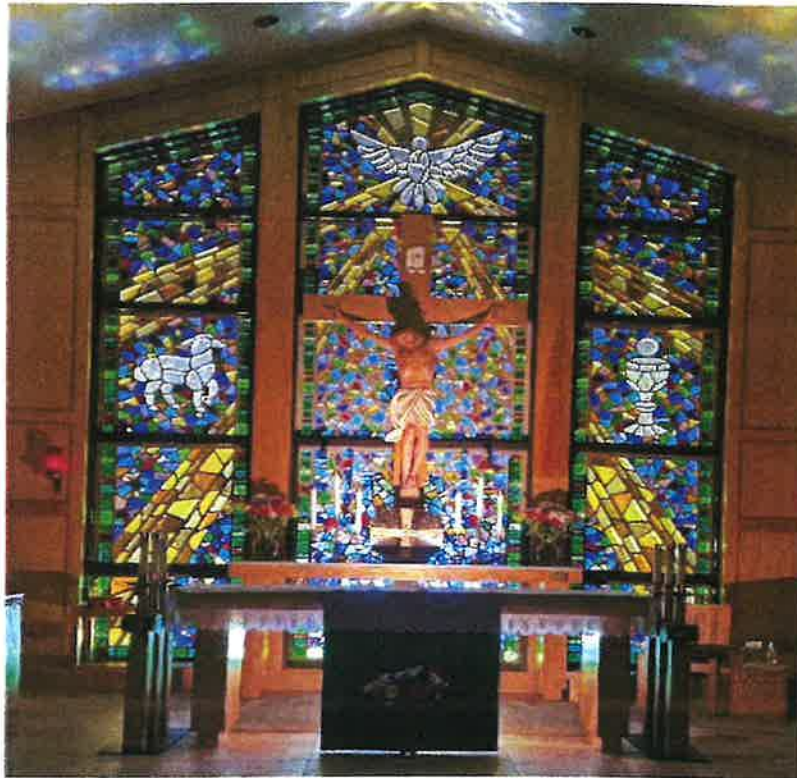

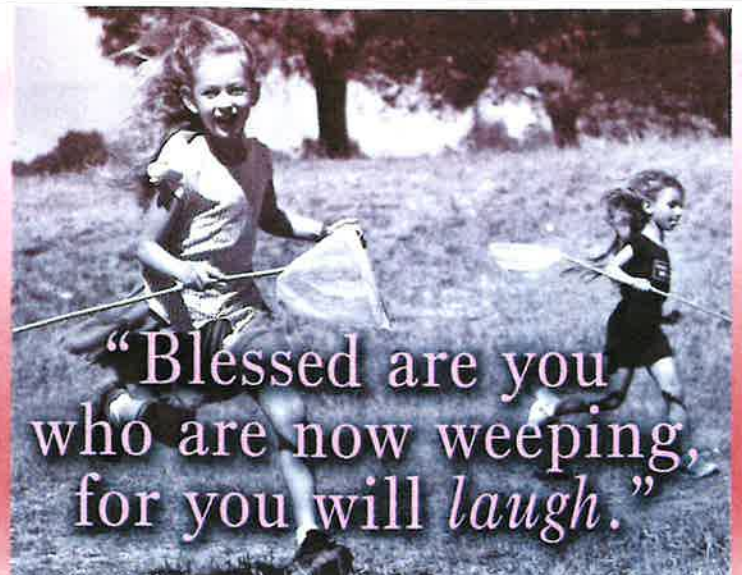

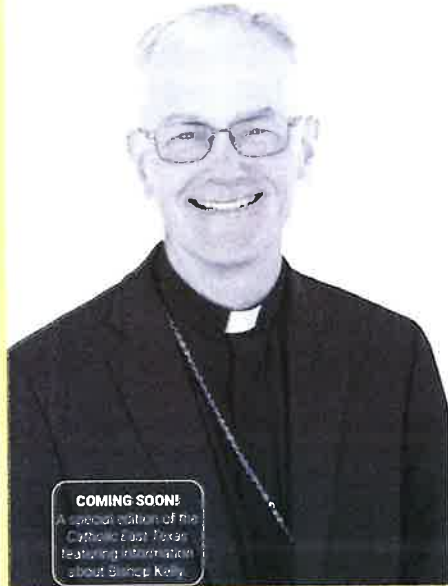

Cathedral of the Annunciation

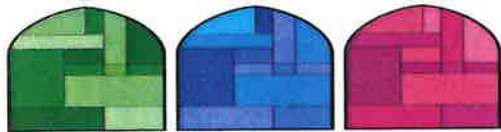
Evening Prayer will be open seating,
