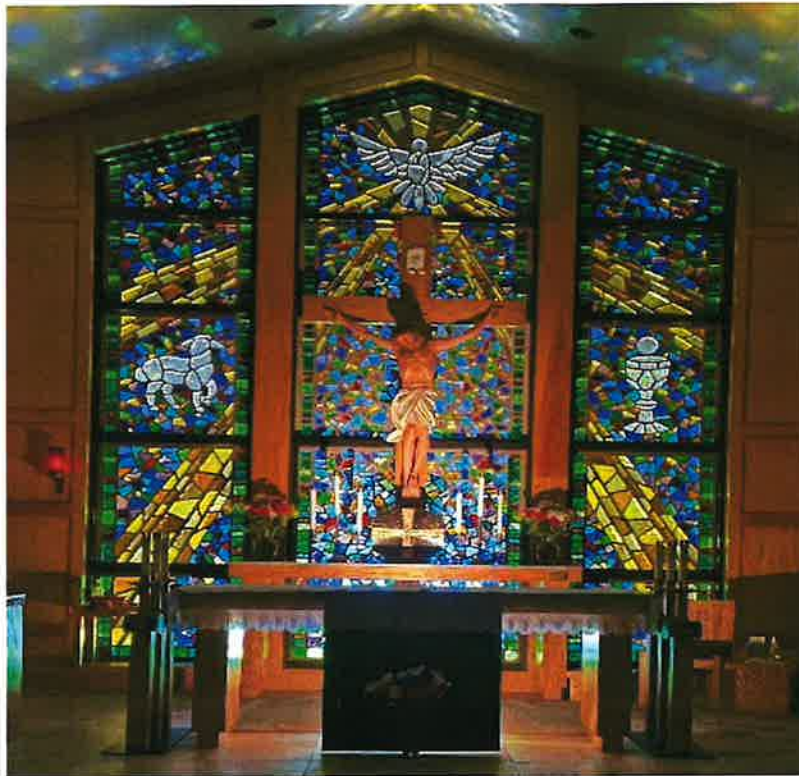

Special Observances



Saturday: THE CHAIR OF ST. PETER THE APOSTLE

(Today's feast, attested as early as the mid-fourth century (in the 'Depositio martyrum'), has its roots in the commemoration of dead relatives and friends ('Parentalia'), celebrated in Rome between 13-22 Feb. At this commemoration, a chair ('cathedral') was left empty for particular deceased persons. Since the actual date of St. Peter's death was unknown, it came to be commemorated on 22 Feb., eventually celebrating his taking pastoral responsibility of the Church of Rome.)

Thursday: St. Gregory of Narek, Abbot, Doctor of the Church (An Armenian mystical and lyrical poet, abbot, and theologian. He is venerated as a saint in the Armenian Apostolic and Catholic Churches and was declared a Doctor of the Church by Pope Francis in 2015 and added to the General Roman Calendar in 2021 as an Optional Memorial. He is best known for his 'Book of Lamentations', a major work of mystical literature.)

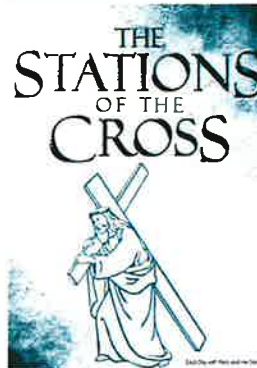
