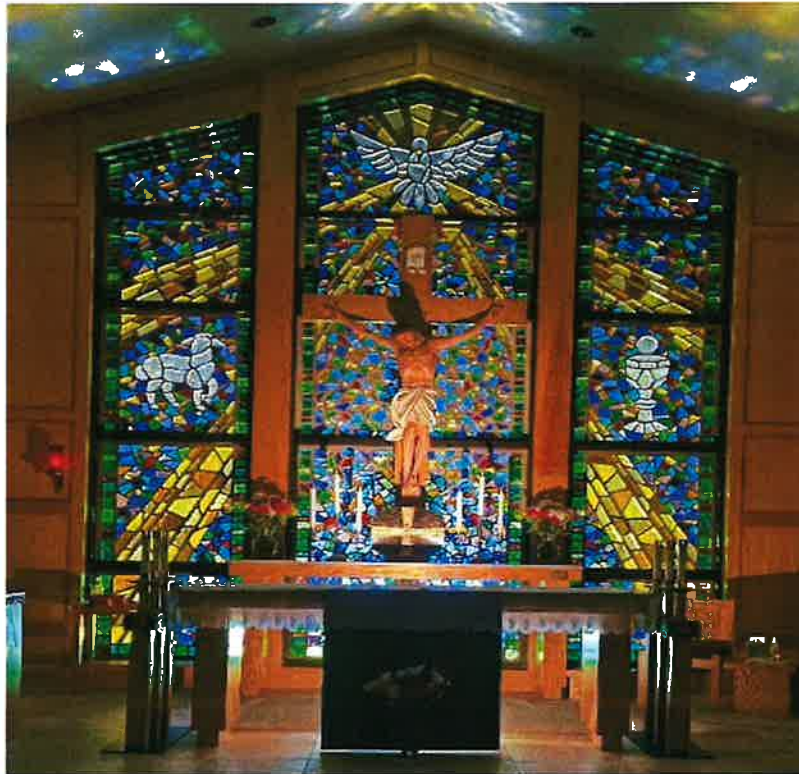

SPECIAL OBSERVANCES

Saturday: St. John of Avila Priest, Doctor of the Church (A Spanish priest, preacher, scholas- tic, author, and religious mystic; called the "Apostle of Andulasia" for his extensive ministry in the region of Spain; the patron of Andulasia and the Spanish secular clergy.)

St. Damien de Veuster Priest (Belgian who joined the Fathers of the Sacred Hearts of Jesus and Mary (Picpus Fathers); arrived in Honolulu in March 1864; in 1873 began his work on Molo- ka'i, used as colony for over 800 lepers; diagnosed with leprosy in 1885; a man of intense interior life and deep simplicity; "I make myself a leper with the lepers, to gain all for Jeus Christ".)

Monday: Sts. Nereus and Achilleus Martyrs (Pope St. Damasus I states that they were Prae- torian soldiers who converted to Christianity; their "acta" report that they were beheaded during the reign of Trajan on the island of Terracina.)

St. Pancras Martyr (His "acts" state that he was a Syrian or Phrygian orphan who came to Rome where he was converted to Christianity; he was beheaded under Diocletian in his 14th year; buried on the Via Aurelia.)

Tuesday: OUR LADY OF FATIMA (Venerated under this title following apparitions to three shepherd children in Portugal in 1917. The message of Fatima includes a call to conversion of heart, repentance from sin, and prayer, especially the Rosary.)

Wednesday: ST. MATTHIAS APOSTLE (Chosen to replace Judas; qualified because he witnessed Jesus' ministry and resurrection; said to have suffered martyrdom either at Colchis— modern day Georgia—or in Jerusalem; mentioned in the Roman Canon.)

Thursday: St. Isidore (Layman whose wife, Maria de la Cabeza is also a saint; farm laborer associated with miracles; patron of Madrid, of farmers and of rural communities.)

A Prayer for the Conclave

Following the death of Pope Francis, the conclave will convene on Wednesday, May 7th. Please pray for the Vatican officials as they select a new pope. Below is a prayer released by Father Chad Ripberger, an exorcist, entrusting the conclave to the Blessed Mother.

Lord Jesus Christ, by entrusting to St. Peter and his successors the keys of the Kingdom of Heaven, thou didst establish the office of the papacy. Grant to thy Church, we beseech thee, a pope who, in his dedication to the Sacred Tradition of the Church, will seek to govern the Church according to the Deposit of Faith and for the salvation of souls.
