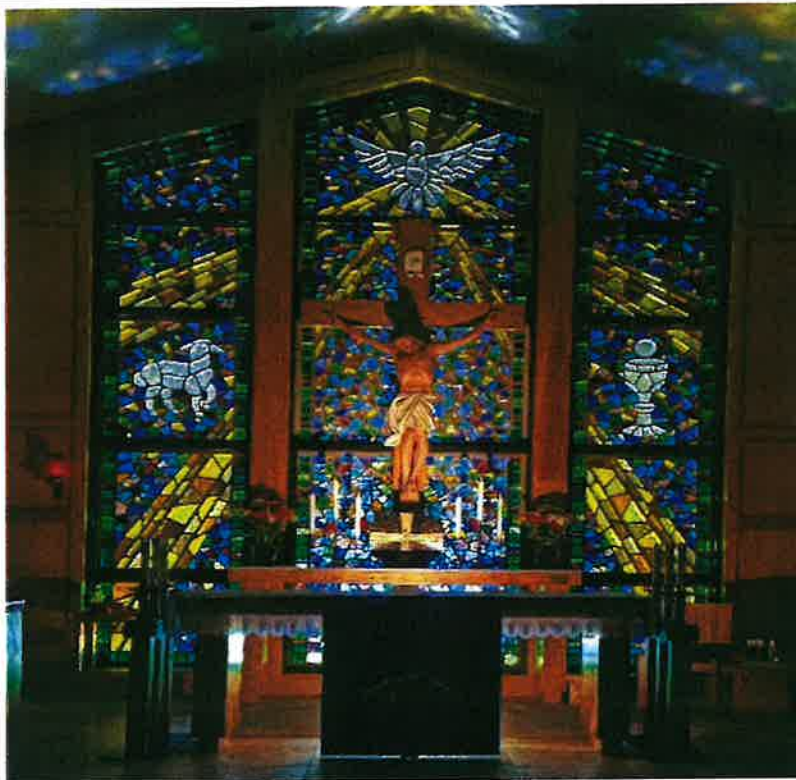

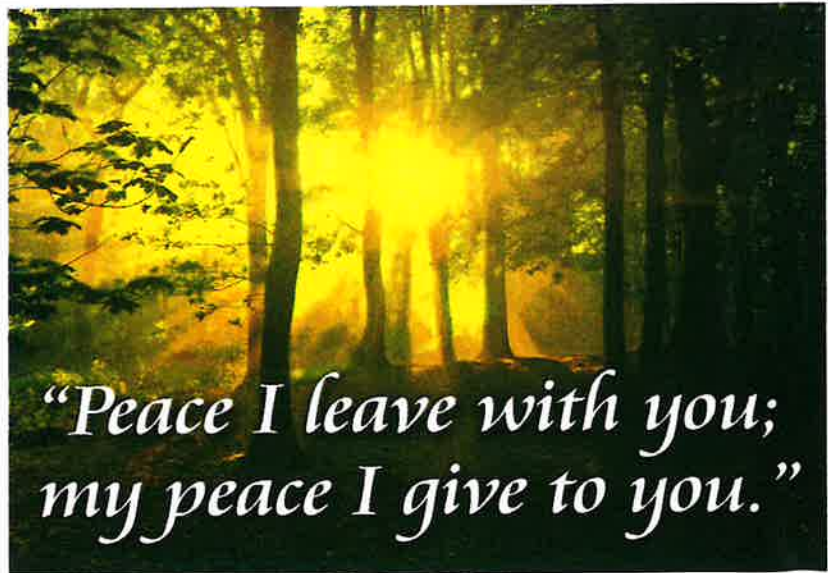

SPECIAL OBSERVANCES



Monday: St. Philip Neri Priest (Founded the Congregation of Priests of the Oratory, today numbering 500 members, to promote holiness of priestly life and foster effective preaching; noted for his joyful and simple spirit, and his use of short, wise maxims; known as the "Apostle of Rome" and "Reformer of the Eternal City".)

Tuesday: St. Augustine of Canterbury Bishop (Monk of Mt. Coelius in Rome; sent with 40 other monks by Pope Gregory I to England; baptized Ethelbert, king of Kent; ordained a bishop in 597; established the Sees of Canterbury, London, and Rochester; in 601, received the pallium as Primate of England.)



Thursday: St. Paul VI Pope (Giovanni Battista Montini was ordained a priest in 1920, he was eventually recruited for the Vatican diplomatic service. For 30 years was Vatican Secretariat of State. In 1954, he was named archbishop of Milan, where he sought to win disaffected workers back to the Catholic Church. In 1958, he was the first of 23 cardinals named by Pope John XXIII, and helped in preparing Vatican II. In 1958, he was named Pope John VI and continued the work of the Council which concluded in December 1965. He increased the number of cardinal significantly, giving many countries their first cardinal; he also instituted a permanent observer mission at the United Nations. He wrote 7 encyclicals including 'Ecclesiam Suam', 'Populorum Progressio', and 'Humanae Vitae'. Other writings included 'Evangellii Nuntiandi', and 'marialis Cultus'. Pope Paul VI died at Castel Gandolfo in 1978; was beatified in 2014 and canonized in 2018.)
