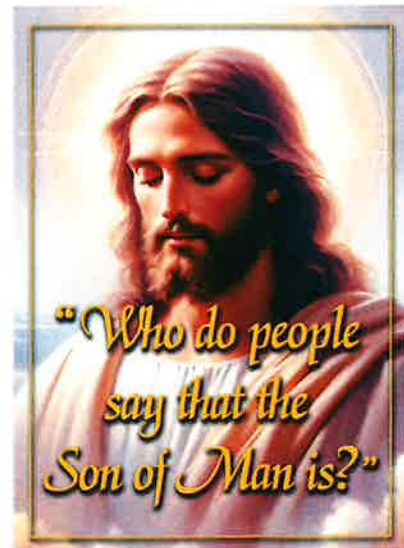

SPECIAL OBSERVANCES

Saturday: THE IMMACULATE HEART OF THE BLESSED VIRGIN MARY "We consecrate to your maternal heart our persons, our families, our country—the whole of humanity. Protect and save us!

St. Irenaeus, Bishop, Martyr, Doctor of the Church (*Irenaeus is from Smyrna; disciple of St. Polycarp; for 25 years the bishop of Lyons; wrote against the Gnostics, especially 'Adversus Haereses'; first to provide a coherent rationale for a Christian Bible including both testaments, and the first to offer a comprehensive account of belief in God's universal providential and redemptive economy.*)

Sunday: STS. PETER AND PAUL, APOSTLES (*Peter was the spokesman for the Twelve who became the "Prince of the Apostles"; patron of those in the fishing industry. Paul was a Pharisee who became the "Apostle of the Gentiles"; patron of the lay apostolate, the Cursillo Movement, and Catholic Action; also of Malta and Greece. Both are principal patrons of Rome.*)

Monday: THE FIRST MARTYRS OF THE HOLY ROMAN CHURCH (*Those many Christians who were tortured, crucified, and burned alive in 64 in Nero's garden on the Vatican Hill are honored today. Both the pagan writer Tacitus, in his 'Annales', and Pope St. Clement I in his letter to the Corinthians testify to the events.*)

Tuesday: St. Junipero Serra, Priest (*From Petra, Majorca, Spain; O.F.M. missionary who arrive in New Spain in 1750p established 9 of the California Missions; baptized over 6,000 native peoples; recognized as a builder of the state of California; Pope John Paul II called him "an exemplary model of the selfless evangelizer".*)

Thursday: St. Thomas, Apostle (*His doubting gave way to faith when he saw the risen Lord; associated with founding the Church in south India; patron of builders, India, and Pakistan.*)

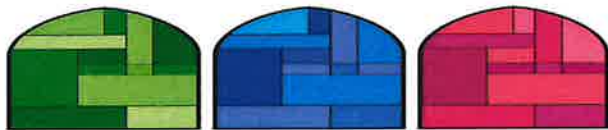
