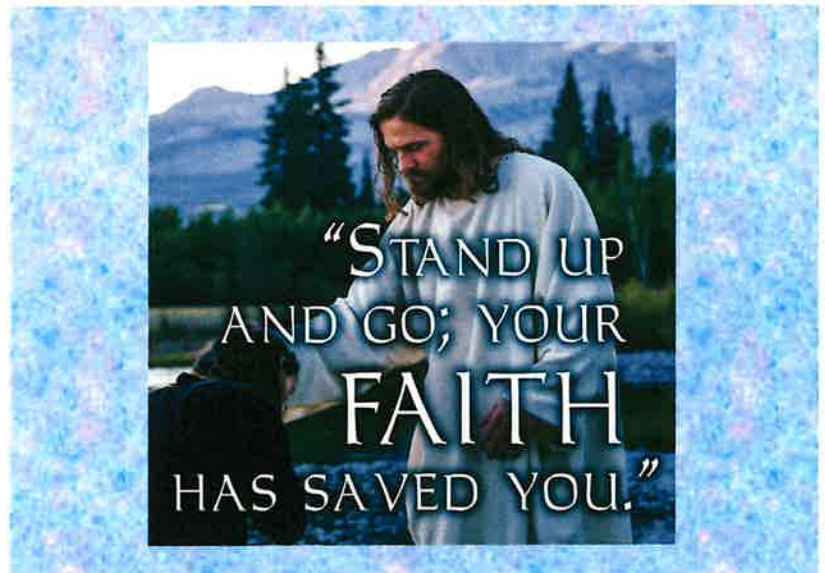

SPECIAL OBSERVANCES

Saturday: St. John XXIII, Pope (Born to a farming family in northern Italy. Angelo Giuseppe Roncalli was ordained a priest in 1904. After serving in WWI as a stretcher-bearer, he was later made national director of the Society for the Propagation of the Faith. In 1925 he became a papal diplomat, serving in Bulgaria, Turkey, and in France. Roncalli helped save an estimated 24,000 Jewish people during WW2. Named cardinal and appointed patriarch of Venice in 1953; elected pope in 1958; his most famous encyclicals were "Mater et Magistra" and "Pacem in Terris". His feast day, October 11, recalls the day of the first session of the Second Vatican Council. Declared a Blesses in 2000.)

Tuesday: St. Callistus I, Pope, Martyr (He incurred the ire of Tertullian and St. Hippolytus over "lapsi" controversy; organized the first official Christian cemetery in Rome and instituted Ember Day fasts.)

Wednesday: St. Teresa of Jesus, Virgin, Doctor of the Church (Teresa of Avila was a Spanish mystic who, with St. John of the Cross, founded the reformed (Discalced) Carmelite friars and nuns, for which she had to endure great trials; authored "Way of Perfection", "Interior Castle", and an autobiography; first woman declared "Doctor of the Church"; patroness of Spain.)

Thursday: St. Hedwig, Religious (Born in Bavaria; duchess of Silesia and mother of seven children; peacemaker dedicated to the poor and prisoners; promoted first Friday devotion.)

St. Margaret Mary Alacoque, Virgin (French Visitandine mystic who promoted devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus, a feast which helped free the Church from the spirit of Jansenism; promoted first Friday devotion.)

Friday: St. Ignatius of Antioch, Bishop, Martyr (Apostolic Father known as the second successor of St. Peter in Antioch; wrote seven letters to local communities on church unity and structure, especially the mono-episcopacy; first to use the term "Catholic Church" as a collective destination for Christians.)
