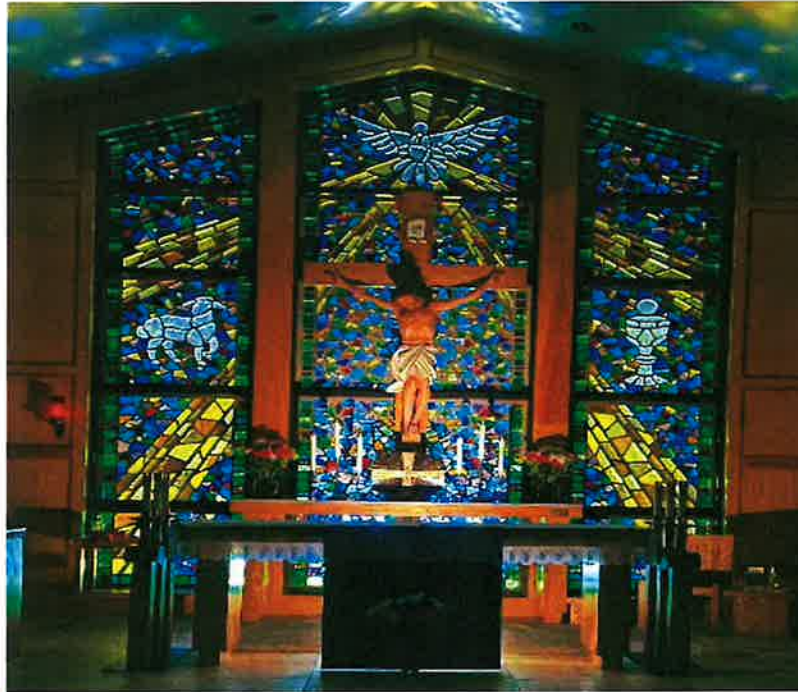

SPECIAL OBSERVANCES

Saturday: St. Albert the Great Bishop, Doctor of the Church (From Swabia; O.P. master of philosophy, theology, and the natural sciences, esp. Aristotle; teacher of St. Thomas Aquinas; Provincial of the German Dominicans, becoming bishop of Regensburg; prolific writer (38 quarto volumes in print); wrote on the cult of the Sacred Heart; patron of scientists.)

Monday: St. Elizabeth of Hungary Religious (Died at age 24; wife of Louis IV of Thuringia and mother of 3; as a widow, she became a Franciscan tertiary, dedicated to the needs of poor and the sick; canonized only 4 years after her death; patroness of the Franciscan Third Order and of Catholic Charities.)

Tuesday: THE DEDICATION OF THE BASILICAS OF STS. PETER AND PAUL APOSTLES (Around 330 Constantine built a basilica over the tomb of St. Peter. Reconstruction began in the 14th c and the present basilica of St. Peter was consecrated 18 Nov 1626 by Pope Urban VIII. The construction of St. Paul's on the Via Ostiense was begun by Valentine II in 386, taking the place of a small church built by Constantine. Destroyed by fire in 1823, the new basilica was consecrated 10 Dec 1854 by Pope Pius IX who joined in one solemn celebration the dedication of these two basilicas.)

St. Rose Philippine Duchesne Virgin (From Grenoble, France; founded the first American house of the Religious of the Sacred Heart; opened the first American free school west of the Mississippi; known for her courage and desire to serve native Americans, esp the Potawatomi who called her the "woman who prays always".)

Friday: THE PRESENTATION OF THE BLESSED VIRGIN MARY (Today's memorial finds its origins in a 1st c apocryphal source, the **Protovangelion** or **Book of James**, and the dedication on 21 Nov 543 of the basilica of St. Mary the New in Jerusalem.)

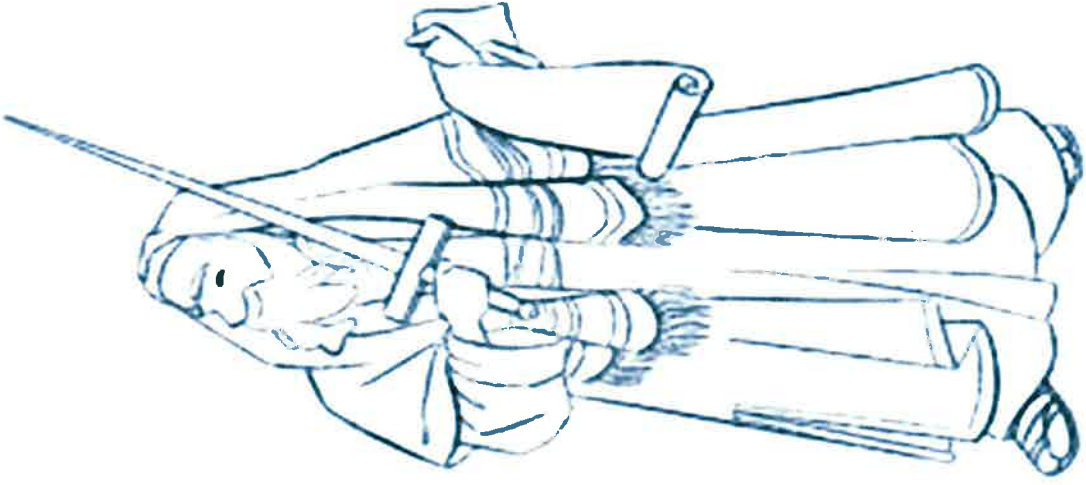


Toys for Tots Marine Corps Reserves

Unwrapped donations need to be dropped off in the Marine Corps' Toys for Tots box (located near the church office) no later than Sunday, December 13th.

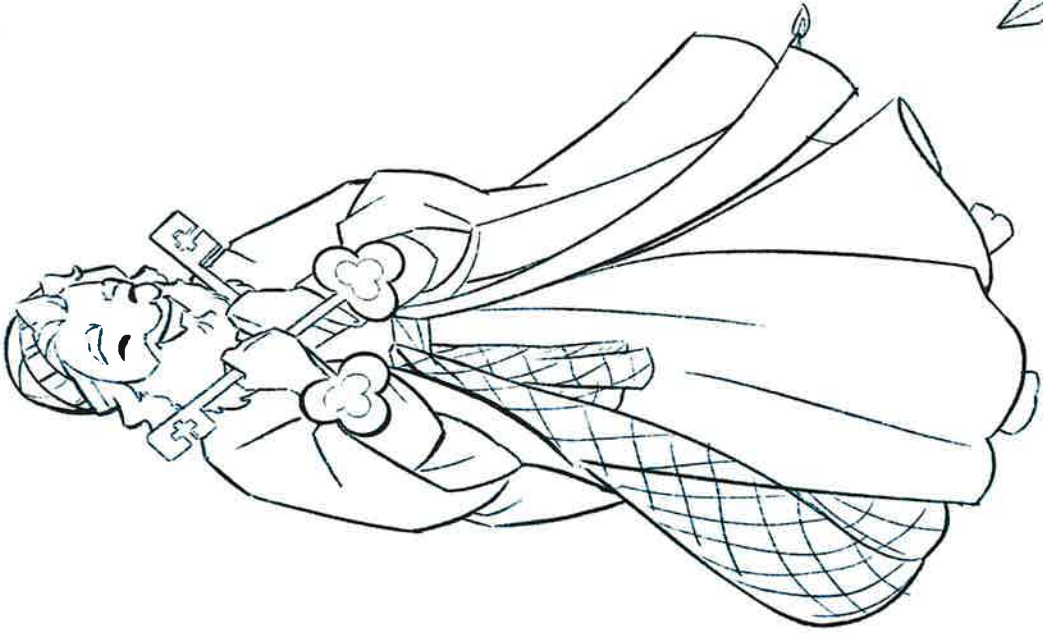
